To Whom It May Concern,

This letter confirms that the materials used in the formulation of *Magic Natural Disinfectant* have undergone dermatological testing conducted by an independent laboratory under controlled conditions.

The product was tested in accordance with two well-established skin compatibility protocols:

1. Human Repeated Insult Patch Test with Challenge (HRIPT)

- Conducted on a panel of **52 adults** with various skin types.
- Repeated applications of the product using a **semi-occlusive patch** caused **no irritation** at the induction site.
- During the challenge phase, a single application to both the previously exposed (induction) site and an unexposed (virgin) site **caused no allergic reactions**.
- **Conclusion:** The product demonstrated **very good skin compatibility and did not exhibit any sensitising effects**.

2. Human Patch Test Under Dermatological Control

- Conducted on a panel of **56 adults** (male and female), aged **20 to 68 years**, with skin phototypes **II to IV** and varying skin types.
- A **single application** of the product using a semi-occlusive patch was applied.
- **No irritation** was observed during the study.
- **Conclusion:** The product demonstrated **very good skin compatibility**.

Based on the results of these independent tests, *Magic Natural Disinfectant* may be considered **dermatologically tested and well-tolerated**, with no evidence of irritation or sensitisation under the conditions evaluated.
